

Bar Association, Continuing Education Sponsor Free Casemaker Training

The Brunswick-Glynn County Bar Association and the Department of Continuing Education at Coastal Georgia Community College are sponsoring Casemaker training for the local legal community. The training is being provided by the Georgia Bar Association at no charge; however, because of space limitations, registrations are mandatory.

Attorneys who attend qualify for continuing legal education (a \$10 fee is applied to the annual CLE statement). Legal assistants may attend if sponsored by an attorney.

The Casemaker website will soon contain legal libraries for all 50 states. Casemaker is also planning to enlarge its current selection of state libraries to include all appellate case law, state constitutions, rules of court, current statutes, as well as other selected items.

Casemaker's state appellate decisional case law content will equal the content found in either Westlaw or LexisNexis back to 1950. And, it will far exceed the state appellate case law content of the other legal publishers, worldwide. These developments make Casemaker the fastest growing online legal research service in the country.

The newest search enhancement will allow users to be able to search in multiple state and federal libraries simultaneously.

The local training is scheduled Wednesday, Jan. 31, at the Southeast Georgia Conference Center, Jerico Computer Lab, Brunswick campus. Session 1 is scheduled 10 a.m.-noon; session 2 is scheduled 2:30-4:30 p.m.
