C. Award Criteria Narrative and Supporting Materials

Please answer the following questions using the space provided below. Provide specific, concrete examples for numbers 1-3, and at least one of the criteria in numbers 4-5.

1. What significant contributions has the individual or employer made to the advancement of diversity in the legal profession?

2. In what way has the individual or employer influenced women lawyers or lawyers of color to pursue legal careers?

3. How has the individual opened doors for women lawyers or lawyers of color in a variety of job settings that historically were closed to them?

4. How has the individual or employer advanced opportunities for women lawyers or lawyers of color within a practice area or segment of the profession?

5. (For individuals) How has the individual achieved professional excellence in his or her field?

In addition, please submit no more than three letters of support from individuals or organizations that speak to these five criteria.

Please note: Only the first three letters of support received will be considered by the Selection Committee.
