Nominations for this position are invited. A member of the Bar may submit his or her own name or the names of others. The public is also invited to submit nominations. Such names (including addresses) should be sent to the undersigned, as court administrator, by June 24, 2026, via email. (By letter addressed to 185 Shirley C. The Office of the Court Administrator will send a questionnaire to each person nominated. The nominee shall submit a digital version of the completed questionnaire on or before July 10, 2026 to the Court Administrator at:

A panel appointed by the chief judge of the State Court of Fulton County will evaluate and interview candidates and the panel will make recommendations to the chief judge for consideration by the judges of the court.

The minimum qualifications for this position are:

- Age: Must be at least 30 years old at the time of appointment.
- Citizenship: Must have been a citizen of Georgia for at least three years.
- Legal experience: Must have practiced law for at least seven years.
- Bar membership: Must be a member in good standing with the State Bar of Georgia.
