## MOTION TO AMEND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE STATE BAR OF GEORGIA

COMES NOW the State Bar of Georgia, pursuant to the authorization and direction of its Board of Governors, respectfully moves that the Rules and Regulations of the State Bar of Georgia be amended as follows:

## **Preface**

The Board of Governors of the State Bar of Georgia met at its regularly scheduled meeting on October 11, 2025. It approved the

proposed rule changes<sup>2</sup> by deleting the struck-through sections and inserting the underlined sections as follows:

## 1 Rule 4-203.1 (a). Uniform Service Rule

- 2 (a) Lawyers shall inform the Membership Department of the State
- 3 Bar of Georgia, in writing, of their Official Address, which shall
- 4 include the lawyer's current name, official mailing address, email
- 5 <u>address</u>, and telephone number. The Supreme Court of Georgia and

Notification of a change of address given to any department of the State Bar of Georgia other 15 16 than the Membership Department shall not satisfy the requirement 17 herein. Should a member fail to include an email address in their Official Address on file with the Membership Department of the 18 19 State Bar of Georgia, neither the Supreme Court of Georgia nor the State Bar of Georgia need comply with any requirement pertaining to 20 emailing set forth herein, and any provision requiring emailing shall 21 22 be deemed satisfied as soon as any requirements other than the 23requirement for emailing have been completed.

If the proposed amendments to the rule are approved, the amended rule will read as it appears under Appendix "A."
