You can draw on a pad!*

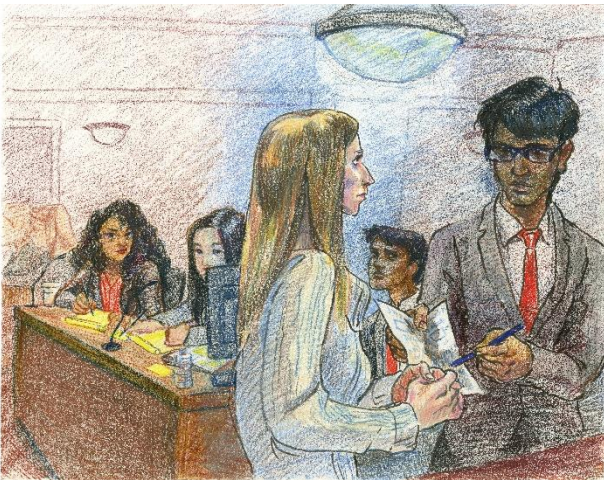
