



—Hotel Information—

We welcome parent and other spectator attendance at this event and hope that as many traveling parents/spectators as possible are able to attend the competition, however please help us to accommodate our traveling students and coaches FIRST by following the hotel reservation suggestions below. Parents/spectators will need to make their own hotel room reservations for the weekend of the state tournament. Participating teams located fewer than 85 miles from the Gwinnett Justice Center may also use the hotel contact information below to make room reservations. The Mock Trial office does not subsidize hotel costs for teams located less than 85 miles away from the competition site.

At the Hotel

Please refrain from loud noises in the hallways, common areas or in the rooms. Additionally, teams (including parents/spectators) should not wear any article of clothing that would indicate which school they are associated with while at the hotel or the courthouse.

Student team member supervision at a hotel during tournament weekend: All student team members must be under the supervision of team coaches and/or adult chaperones associated with their team at all times during their stay at a hotel during tournament weekend. Males are not allowed in female rooms and vice versa. The Code of Ethical Conduct holds all participants in the Georgia High School Mock Trial

Competition to a high standard of behavior and we expect students to meet this standard at all times during the competition weekend, including while staying at a hotel.

Special Note for State Finalists

We have made special arrangements with the Hampton Inn regarding traveling teams (students and coaches) that may need lodging because they are Finalists competing late afternoon/early evening on Saturday. The Mock Trial staff will alert the hotel on Saturday evening to expect any traveling team advancing to the Final Round for an additional night. However, parents and other spectators will be responsible for handling their own hotel reservations for Saturday evening, if they wish to stay in Lawrenceville after the Final Round.
