Important Deadlines

December 31, 2017 Your 2017 annual CLE requirement should be complete by December 31, 2017.

March 31, 2018 Your 2017 annual CLE requirement must be complete by March 31, 2018.
You will owe a **\$100 Late CLE Fee** if your 2017 CLE requirement is not completed by March 31, 2018.

Annual CLE Requirement: 12 hours per year including 1 ethics hour, 1 professionalism hour, and 3 trial hours.

Trial Hour Requirement: Trial hours must be completed only by those attorneys who appeared (by filing pleadings, in person, or otherwise) as sole or lead counsel in the Superior or State Courts of Georgia during 2017.

In-House / Distance Learning Cap: A maximum of 6 hours (of the 12 CLE hours required per year) can be completed through a combination of approved in-house seminars/distance learning seminars (online seminars, live webcasts, etc.). If you have any questions about how many additional in-house/distance learning hours you can use to complete your 2017 CLE requirement, please call the CLE department 404-527-8710.

Course Fees: Course fees must be paid by the attorney if the seminar sponsor does not pay the fee. Attorney course fees are computed at \$5 per credit hour, and the amount due per year is capped at \$120. Courses/hours with fees due will be deleted from the attorney's CLE transcript if these fees are not paid; however, these courses/hours can be added back to the CLE transcript if fees are paid at a later date. Make all checks payable to CCLC and mail with this form to the address below.

For any unlisted CLE courses that you attended in 2017, please attach information about the course including date, sponsor, title, location and number of hours attended.
